This list of survey topics and variables provides an overview of the five years, 1998 (E1), 1999 (E2), 2000 (E3), 2001 (E4) and 2002 (E5) of phase 1 of the *Quebec Longitudinal Study of Child Development (QLSCD 1998-2002*). The topics and variables are presented here by focus, namely the target child, selected sibling, household, family and couple, mother, father or spouse, and biological parents not living in the household. Notice that a variable could be found in more than one topic. The table includes the survey instrument and number of variables measured for each topic.
