The entire "I Am, I'll Be" team is pleased to announce that the next round of data collection will take place in spring 2015! The answers you will provide then will allow us to establish a realistic picture of what young people in Québec think and experience. You'll be informed of the details of this data collection in the coming months.

A kit based on the "I Am, I'll Be" study data

In February, the Institut launched the SurvEd kit on success in school. This tool consists of 13 fact sheets that summarize results of the publications produced from the study data. These sheets are short, simple and cover topics such as teacher-student relationship, motivation, victimization and school success. The information you've provided since you were five-month-old now helps teachers and school stakeholders in their work with young people!

Did you know that...

- > June 12 is the World Day Against Child Labour? Child labour is often defined as work that deprives children of their childhood, potential and dignity, and endangers their mental, moral or physical well-being.
- > The International Labour Organization held the first World Day Against Child Labour in 2002 to draw attention to this issue and the actions and efforts made to eliminate it?
- > Worldwide, more than 160 million children age 5 to 14 are forced to work?
- > Textiles, carpet manufacturing, mining and tobacco and cocoa harvesting are sectors where many child labourers are found?
- > Since 2000, the number of child labourers dropped by a third, while the number of children involved in hazardous labour decreased by half? However, considerable efforts are still needed to completely eliminate child labour...
