## Did you know that...

- > There is a prestigious award in recognition of the brilliant work researchers are doing in criminology around the world? It's called the Stockholm Prize in Criminology.
- > This acclaimed prize is also known as the Nobel of Criminology, given its importance in the eyes of the world's scientific community?
- > The founder of the *I am, I'll be* survey, Dr. Richard E. Tremblay, is the recipient of the 2017 Stockholm Prize in Criminology? He has authored more than 500 scientific articles, of which dozens have focused on the data from *I am, I'll be*. Among many topics related to the survey, he has done research on aggressive behaviours and bullying in young children. He has demonstrated that the peak age for violent behaviour is not 20 years of age, but rather three.
- > Thanks to you and other participants in such surveys, researchers are continually expanding our knowledge with their exceptional work.
